# **BEFORE You Come to School**

## **Let's Each Do Our Part**

#### Protect Yourself & Others

- Stay home if you are sick
- Wash your hands often
- Keep your hands away from nose & mouth
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick
- Expanded Employee Training about COVID-19 & prevention measures
- Bring your mask/face covering with you

#### Added Health Checks for Students, Teachers & Staff

- Each day, take child's temperature \*BEFORE\* leaving home > if temp 99.0 or above, keep them home
- This also applies to teachers & staff

# **Car Lines** - Parents Remain in Car Until We Signal You

Read car line schedules & details here under "Arriving & Leaving Each Day" >> Lower School >> Car line

Escort your Lower School student(s) to & from their classroom(s) until car lines begin Sept 7.

Then you will be given a day each week to walk your child inside.

Toddler parents escort your child to & from their classroom all school year.

#### Arrival Car Line

- Wait until your scheduled time to enter parking lot
- Put car line tag on rearview mirror
- Unbuckle child's seatbelt & gather their belongings
- Make sure child wears required mask/face covering\*\*
- We will escort child into the building, check their temp & spray their hands with hand sanitizer

#### Leaving Car Line

- Wait until your scheduled time to enter parking lot
- Put car line tag on rearview mirror
- We will escort child from building to the car
- You put away child's belongings
   buckle them into seatbelt/car seat

# **DURING School**

## **We'll Learn & Have Fun - Safely**

- Share age-appropriate info about how we work together to protect ourselves from COVID-19
- Encourage frequent handwashing hand sanitizer will be provided when soap & water are unavailable
- Emphasize respiratory etiquette
- Temperature checks for students, staff & visitors

#### Safe Distancing

- Encourage social distancing
- Focus on handwashing before & after eating
- Personal nap kit for toddlers & 3-year olds, including nap mat & bed roll\*
  - \*Parents must purchase bed roll and nap kit container

#### ▶ \*\*Masks

- Indoors: Anyone 3 years & older must wear a mask
- Outdoors: Masks optional

#### ▶ Our Campus

- Specialized <u>medical grade air purifiers</u> in every classroom & common area
- Child-sized sink & soap in each classroom
- Signs to encourage important behavior
- Increased controls on who can visit campus
- We will offer school lunch service (no other food deliveries accepted)

# If Someone Gets Sick

 Anyone with fever or COVID-19 symptoms will be isolated and sent home immediately

# \*If COVID-19 suspected or confirmed, the school will\*



• Coordinate with local & state health departments

# \*Individuals with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 can return to school when ALL 3 of these criteria met:

- 1. at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared or 7 days with negative COVID test
- 2. symptoms have improved (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and
- at least 24 hours has passed with no fever & no fever-reducing medications

\*Individuals with fever and no <u>COVID-19 symptoms</u> can return to school when at least 24 hours have passed without fever (no medication)

#### ▶ When to Quarantine

- All family members w/ confirmed positive COVID must quarantine for 10 days
- No quarantine needed if not directly exposed & no symptoms
